John's Method for Growing Live Sphagnum Moss

- Bottom layer of shredded Long Fiber Sphagnum Moss, soaked to rehydrate completely.
- Low long container with slits to eliminate complete flooding.
- Inoculate with chopped or shredded Live Sphagnum Moss from any source, i.e., a bog, existing plants.
- Grow in bright light, but not direct sunlight.
- Water with pure water or rainwater. I do use tap water to start but my tap water is very good.
- Harvest as needed, but never completely, to keep moss growing continuously.
- Keep cool in winter with bright light. If the moss is hardy, it can be kept outside all winter.
