This month we will be holding a bog walk at Ponemah Bog in Amherst, NH. Plans are to meet in the parking lot of Panera Bread, 590 Amherst St (Rt 101A), Nashua NH 03063 at **10AM**. Then we should car-pool as the parking lot at Ponemah bog is very limited. The entire hike should take 1-2 hours.

It is an easy hike with board walks, no long boots necessary (unless it is flooded after a heavy rain). You will see lots of *S. purpurea*, *D. intermedia*, *D. rotundifolia*, and *U. cornuta*. The morphological diversity of the *Sarracenia* is amazing; multiple different patterns and colors exist side-by-side!
